

How will your grades be awarded this summer?



So, what do we know?

- 1. Still an unfolding picture- we will continue to share information when we have it.
- 2. You have *every* chance of success in *every* assessment.
- 3. An evidence base must support a grade.
- 4. Exam boards will provide schools with detailed guidance on how to make grade judgments by the end of the spring term and will also publish "optional" assessment materials by Easter.
- 5. Teachers can use a **"range of evidence",** including mock exam results, coursework, or other work completed as part of a pupil's course, 'such as essays or in-class tests' to arrive at their judgments.
- 6. Assurance that grades will be awarded 'fairly and consistently' and there is a rigorous and robust process.
