Buddhism Tasks

If you did not study Buddhism at GCSE then please complete the Buddhism home learning booklet that is also attached to the Induction page.

Use this link - <u>A handful of leaves</u> to access Paul Gethin's book 'The Foundations of Buddhism'. Read the introduction and up to page 36 about the Historical Buddha. Create a timeline of the events leading up to the Buddha's birth – bring this with you to our first lesson.

Research the history of the Caste system in India (use https://www.bbc.co.uk/news/world-asia-india-35650616 as a starting point) to understand the type of society that the Buddha was born into. Create an A4 summary page about the Caste system.
