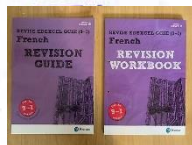
Highlighter Procedure

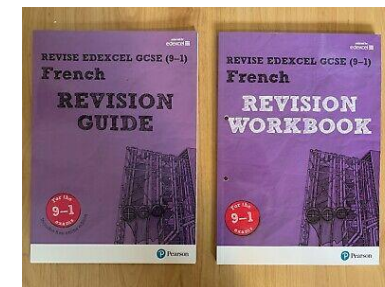
