Parent Subject/Tutor Evenings, 2023-24: As you are aware, we moved to online Tutor and Subject Teacher Evening appointments during the Pandemic and have kept to this model since. As we all know, young people get one chance only to receive a good education, and it remains our priority to ensure every child attends school regularly, feels safe and supported once here, and is ready for learning; we know it isn't always easy, but with Home and School working in partnership we can ensure every young person gets the best provision possible.
