Characters and Comics

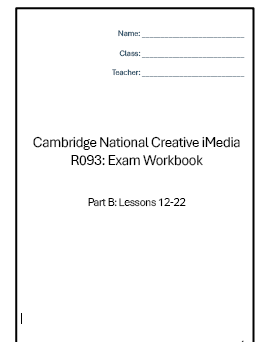
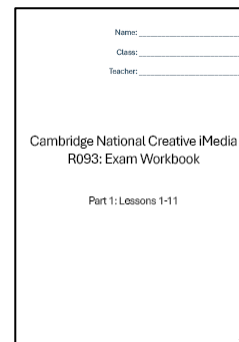
## Year 11 NEA

This is a set-assignment from the exam board and will change every year. The work towards this must be completed in lesson time using guidance from your teacher but it must be all your own work. Period 6 sessions are planned for the Autumn term to facilitate any catch-up needed from lost learning.

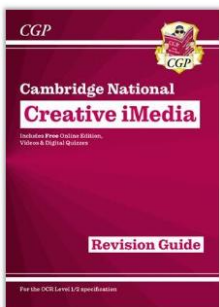
## Year 11 Mock Exams

The February mock exam will be an R093 past paper. Past Papers to practice with are in the Year 11 Curriculum Team (see below). To prepare you for R093 work booklets are used both in lessons and for home study.

The R093 unit is broken down into “lessons” numbered from 1-21. These align with the teaching resources which are also in the Year 11 Curriculum Team (see below).

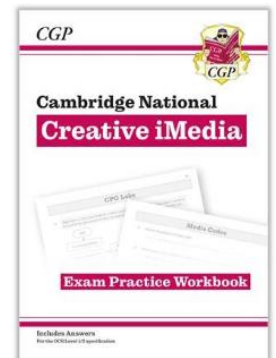


## Revision Resources
