

# How to revise for A-level Maths

Here's a step-by-step guide to revising effectively:

## 1. Use your knowledge organiser.

- Your knowledge organiser is powerful revision tool that summarises key information on each topic. It usually includes definitions, key facts, diagrams and example questions.:
- Each topic has a **topic quiz**. When we have completed a unit, you should work through these questions to assess your understanding. The answers are all available in the Files area of your Teams channel.

## 2. Tackle Exam Questions by Topic

Focus on exam-style questions related to the topic you're revising. Work through as many as possible until you're consistently getting them right.

- **ALevelMathsRevision.com** is a good website for this
- In the Files section of your Teams channel there is a section called AS exam practise booklet. This folder contains a booklet put together by MEI, with exam questions for each chapter of the textbook, along with the answers and worked solutions.

## 3. Use Video Tutorials

- If you are still unsure of a topic as you are working through the quiz and exam questions, then use video tutorials specifically tailored to the A Level Maths syllabus to reteach yourself.

## 4. Practise Textbook Examples

- Use the textbook to reinforce what you've learned. Don't stop practising just because you *think* you understand a topic—keep going until the questions feel repetitive and easy.
