Try the **revision activities** in your revision guide.

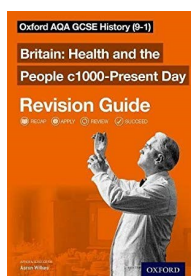
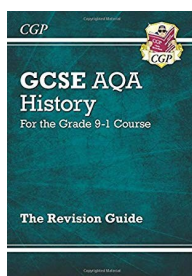
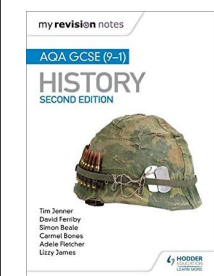
Produce **flashcards** (and test yourself / get others to test you) on key knowledge.
