We are delighted to announce that Aspiration Week, an action-packed enrichment programme for Years 7—9, will run from Monday 13th July to Friday 17th July 2020 inclusive. The programme will run over 5 days. During these 5 days the normal school timetable will be suspended and replaced by a fabulous menu of activities to suit all interests, giving all young people the chance to try new things or improve their skills and knowledge in hobbies or interests outside school and to work with other young people across the age range. There are opportunities for sports, outdoor and adventure activities, creative and arts-based activities, science, technology and nature experiences and possibilities to improve or to try new hobbies and interests. We have tried hard to cater for all interests and purses and we are convinced that there will definitely be something in this booklet to light every young person's fire!

Choosing an Activity

Please read through all the activity details in this booklet. Some activities may require early departures or may return to Hele's School later than usual, and some activities may require students to meet at an alternative location, e.g. Girl Power, Golf, Mount Batten Week, etc. It is important that young people can make their own way safely to and from Hele's School at these times should they wish to pick these activities. **Please note** activities will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and it is <u>essential</u> that we hold the Off Site Trip/Medical Consent form for each child to process their application.

All activities are identified by a three letter code. Students should choose **three** activities in order of preference and complete the application form at the back of this booklet. Incomplete forms will be returned. The form should be returned to the collection box in <u>THE LIBRARY</u> no later than 9am on FRIDAY 20TH DECEMBER. Please DO NOT hand your form to your Tutor.

The collection box will be emptied several times a day and each form is date stamped.

Confirmation of a place on an activity will be given as soon as all lists of participants have been agreed. We anticipate that this will be some time in the **week beginning Monday 13th January.** Once your choice has been confirmed you will **NOT** be able to swap to another activity without the consent of your Head of House, so choose wisely! Whilst we will do everything we can to satisfy first choices, this may not always be possible. There are over 660 students making choices and most of the activities have a maximum number of participants. Likewise, if there are insufficient numbers opting for an activity then regrettably the activity may need to be cancelled and an alternative offered. If you have any questions about an activity you are interested in, then please get in touch with the **member of staff identified as an 'Information Point' on each activity.**

Conduct and Behaviour

We expect students to maintain their high standard of conduct and behaviour during Aspiration Week. We welcome applications for all activities from all students, but in exceptional circumstances it may be that a young person is refused a place on the grounds of previous, poor or dangerous behaviour. We take our safeguarding duties seriously and are not willing to jeopardise the enjoyment or safety of any child on any activity. Alternative on-site provision would be made for any youngster who is felt to pose too much of a risk to take part in particular activities. Likewise, instances of poor or dangerous behaviour during an activity may result in a child being removed from an activity. If this is the case, a refund will not be possible and parents/carers may be instructed to collect them from where the activity is taking place.

Attendance

Please note that Aspiration Week is an integral part of your child's education. Attendance is **NOT** optional; it is part of our school term and it is important that normal attendance is maintained. Any absence not supported by an acceptable reason (e.g. illness or medical appointment) will be recorded as an unauthorised absence.

Other Information

If a youngster is in receipt of a free school meal then these will be ordered in advance for them. Otherwise, meals can be purchased from the School Canteen as normal for School-based activities. Off-site activities will require a packed lunch to be provided or money to purchase refreshments.

And finally...

We know that Aspiration Week will be a fun, action-packed and deep learning experience for all involved; we can't wait! I hope that you share our enthusiasm as you read through this booklet and see the opportunities on offer to our young people. Our intention is to make this an awesome week so that it continues to be a central part of the Hele's School experience each year!

Aspiration Week has the following key learning objectives:

- To provide our learners with a valuable social and educational experience (not usually available within the traditional school day) during which they can:
 - develop self confidence and self esteem;
 - improve their motivation to learn new and challenging skills;
 - enhance their communication skills;
 - learn and develop team working skills;
 - become resourceful and resilient;
 - accept and take on increasing levels of responsibility;
 - change/develop attitudes and values and respect the value of differences between people.
- To provide an inclusive programme of learning which meets all budgets and interests.
- To provide a programme which gives learners opportunities to gain national qualifications and certificates, wherever appropriate.
- To provide many opportunities for learners to experience success and to celebrate their achievements.
- To develop trust and the 'Team Hele's spirit' throughout the week developing, improving and strengthening relationships between learners, staff and the community.
- To provide learners with opportunities to complete active citizenship projects.
- To engage learners in fun and active reviews, where they reflect and think about what they have learned about themselves and others from these experiences, how they could benefit from these insights both back at School and in other areas of their life.

Payment for Activities

The cost for each activity is shown at the bottom of each page, along with arrangements for payment. Some costs are approximate and will usually depend upon the final numbers opting for each activity, **although the amount shown in the booklet will be the maximum amount you can expect to pay**. Arrangements have been made to try to subsidise activities wherever possible to keep costs manageable.

Payments cannot be made until places have been confirmed by letter and will then appear on your ParentPay account. Once you have received confirmation of your child's place on an activity, you will be asked to pay either the amount in full or to pay the first instalment. Please refer to the individual activity outlines for payment requirements. Payment will act as a **non-refundable** and **non-transferable** deposit, so please make choices carefully! (Note: the only exception to this rule is if the School has to cancel an activity due to insufficient numbers opting to do it; the deposit will be refunded in full in this case.)

Deposits will be required by **1st February 2020**. All payments must be completed by **1st May 2020** for a student to participate in their chosen activity.

The most convenient means of payment, for both the School and for you, is by using the **ParentPay** link and we urge you to use this facility. This gives the flexibility to make payments whenever you choose, as well as eradicating the risk of your child 'misplacing' your hard earned cash or cheques on their way to school! ParentPay can be accessed via the school website:

If you do not have access to the internet and ParentPay, you can pay by cash or a cheque made out to "West Country Schools Trust — Hele's School" This must be in a sealed envelope marked with your child's name, Tutor Group and activity on the front.

If students are taking part in an activity that involves long journeys or specialist activities, you may be invited to an information evening nearer the time. This will give you a chance to meet staff members and find out more about the activity.

- Bonus trip to Woodlands Leisure Park and see the Hawk Display



(And of course there will be an opportunity to watch some of the wonderful films as well.)





Mountain Bikes!

Mountain bike activity, off-road, all-terrain cycling. Includes visits to Haldon Forest mountain bike trails, Lanhydrock, Bodmin, Cornwall, as well as local sites. You will be supervised by members of staff who are qualified Mountain Bike instructors and will be taught a range of riding skills and techniques to improve your capabilities during the week.
